YOU'RE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE

Community residents are invited to participate in this annual town wide activity organized by the Grantham Garden Club. Blue litter bags for trash pickup will be provided at registration, courtesy of

“New Hampshire the Beautiful - Litter Free Blue Bag Program”

associated with the Sponsor-A-Highway program through the NH Department of Transportation.

HERE'S HOW TO PARTICIPATE

STEP 1 Volunteer individually or as a group to clean up an area where there's trash.

STEP 2 Start by completing a **PARTICIPANT FORM** when you register at either location.

STEP 3 Once registered, you'll be handed **blue litter bags for collecting trash**.

STEP 4 When you've filled your litter bags, **drop them off at the Grantham Transfer Station**. If you can't get there, **go to the Town Hall by noon and load them into the designated pickup truck**.

IMPORTANT SAFETY REMINDERS

- Children and youth under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Wear gloves, a safety vest, sturdy footwear, and brightly colored clothing.
- We recommend wearing a hat, long sleeves, and long pants.
- When driving to a location, park safely off the road with flashers on.
- Stay alert for passing traffic when picking up trash along a roadside.
- Pay attention to your footing when walking on uneven ground.
- If you find medical or drug waste, or any other suspect materials, call Hanover Police Dispatch at 603.643.2222 and they will send someone to help.
