On the tour, you'll learn not only about his love and attention to his gardens, but also about the history and variety of hostas, how the variegation is produced, how blue hostas create their flattering color, the care and feeding of the plants, when and how to properly divide hostas, avoiding slugs, bugs and deer; and arranging your hostas like a painting in your garden.



About the speaker: Jim taught accounting and computer courses at Claremont's Community College for 26 years. He and his wife have lived at their current home for 37 years. When he is not out tending to his gardens, he also enjoys painting with watercolors in his studio/art gallery. One of his paintings was included in a calendar of New England artists.
